## Have a party with a purpose!

**Chili Cook-Off:** A fun idea that can involve a larger organization or spiritual community. Ask for an "entry fee" donation, recruit a panel of judges, and let onlookers make a donation to enjoy a bowl of chili.

**Party!** Plan a party around a holiday (4th of July, Halloween...) or your birthday. Ask your friends and family to make a meaningful donation and include your fundraising link on your invites. During the party, take a moment to share the importance of funding lung cancer research.
